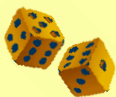
### RALLY INCLUDES

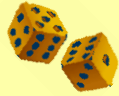

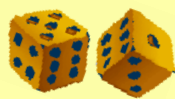

### From the South:

I-95 to Emporia, Virginia,

Route 58 east to I-64, to

Route 13 to the Chesapeake Bay Bridge Tunnel.

Out of the tunnel on route 13 to Pocomoke City, MD to Route 113 to Milford, DE.

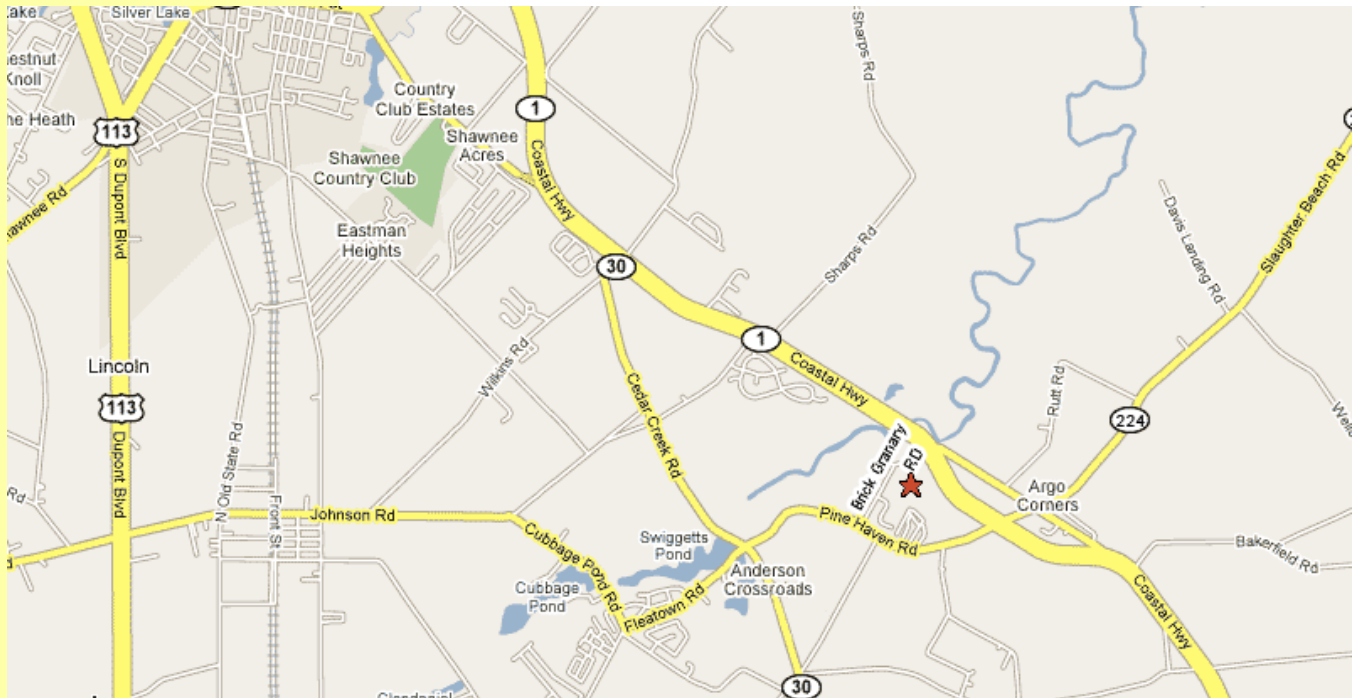
Turn right off of route 113 on route 14.

Go through town to route 1 south.

Go south about 4 miles. Turn right on Brick Granary road.

Go about 1/8 mile, campground is on the left.

NOTE: There is a toll at the tunnel. \$4 or \$5 per axle.



### From the North:

Go south on I-95.

In Delaware, exit I-95 onto route 1 south.

Take route 1 south about 65 miles.

After the Milford exits, go about 4 miles and turn right on Brick Granary road.

Go about 1/8 mile, campground is on the left.

### From the South West:

Pick up I-495 around Washington D.C., to route 50 east.

Go over the Chesapeake Bay Bridge on route 50 to route 404.

Left on route 404 to Denton, Maryland. Get off at route 313 exit, turn left.

Go on route 313 about 2 or 3 miles and turn right on route 317.

When you cross into Delaware, route 317 turns into route 14.

Take route 14 thru Harrington, DE and straight thru Milford, DE to route 1 south.

Go south about 4 miles. Turn right on Brick Granary road.

Go about 1/8 mile, campground is on the left.
